REQUIREMENTS FOR DEMOLITION PERMIT

□ Provide a notarized letter from the homeowner authorizing the contractor to demolish the house. The letter must be accompanied by a copy of the warranty deed.

□ Submit a permit application for demolition, electrical, plumbing, and gas connections if applicable.

□ Submit an Asbestos Report (not required for single-family homes).

□ Provide a copy of the notification sent to utility companies for discontinuance of services such as gas, water, electric, etc.

□ Submit a certification letter from a pest control company, indicating that the property has been cleared of rodents, roaches, pests, etc.

□ Obtain a notarized letter from the contractor responsible for the demolition, notifying the scheduled date of demolition.

□ Provide a survey of the property reflecting the work area.

□ Submit a separate permit application along with details and specifications for the required temporary fence around the perimeter of the property where the existing structure is being demolished.

Note: The demolition of buildings and structures must comply with the requirements of the 2020 FBC (Florida Building Code), including section 3303 of FBC, Building.
