2021 Village Council Election - April 13, 2021 BE REGISTERED HE OR SHE CAN REQUEST A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT

VOTE BY MAIL (VBM):

If you are presently registered to vote in Miami-Dade County and need to request a VBM ballot, you may request a VBM ballot online, by email, fax, phone or mail. Miami-Dade County voters may choose to receive a VBM ballot for a specific election, or for all elections in which they are eligible to vote through the end of the second regularly scheduled general election. Please note if you selected a 2-year request for VBM ballots, your ballot will be automatically sent to you for the 2021 Miami Shores Village Council Election. If you're not sure if your VBM status has expired, you may confirm your status by contacting the telephone number or email listed below.

SIGNATURE UPDATE:

Because it is common for signatures to change over the years, please make sure Miami-Dade County Elections Department has your latest signature. To update your signature, please visit: https://www. miamidade.gov/elections/library/forms/voterregistration-application.pdf. Updates submitted on a Voter Registration Application must contain the voter's original signature.

Signature updates must be completed before your vote-by-mail ballot is received.

DEADLINE TO REQUEST VBM:

No later than 5 p.m. on the 10th day before the election: April 3, 2021 for the Miami Shores Village Council Election.



COUNCIL INFORMATION

The March 2021 meeting will be held at 6:30 PM on Tuesday, March 2nd and March 16th in the 9900 NE 2nd Avenue Building, Miami Shores, FL 33138.

RECENT COUNCIL ACTION

- Approved an ordinance on first reading, establishing irrigation/ water conservation measures in accordance with the South Florida Water Management District's Chapter 40E-24, Florida Administrative Code.
- Approved a resolution, confirming the Village Council's intent to utilize the uniform method of levy and collection of non-ad valorem assessments for the purpose of funding a wastewater collection program within the Shores Estates Residential Subdivision.
- The Village Council deferred the consideration of changing the length of boats that can be stored in backyards from 26 feet to 30 feet to the Planning Board and for such review and recommendations to be brought forth for Council consideration.
